

# The LORD Is . . .

**God** - Acknowledge and take to heart this day that the LORD is God in heaven above and on the earth below. There is no other (Dt 4:39).

**One** - Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one (Dt 6:4).

**Shepherd** - Hear us, O Shepherd of Israel, you who lead Joseph like a flock; you who sit enthroned between the cherubim, shine forth before Ephraim, Benjamin and Manasseh. Awaken your might; come and save us. Restore us, O God; make your face shine upon us, that we may be saved (Ps 80:1-3).

**Love** - And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in him (1 Jn 4:16).

**Provider** - The wild animals honor me, the jackals and the owls, because I provide water in the desert and streams in the wasteland, to give drink to my people, my chosen, the people I formed for myself that they may proclaim my praise (Isa 43:20-21).

**Defender** - A father to the fatherless, a defender of widows, is God in his holy dwelling (Ps 68:5).

**Father** - I will proclaim the decree of the LORD: He said to me, "You are my Son ; today I have become your Father" (Ps 2:7).

**Almighty** - When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared to him and said, "I am God Almighty ; walk before me and be blameless (Ge 17:1).

**I am** - God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I AM has sent me to you' " (Ex 3:14); "I tell you the truth," Jesus answered, "before Abraham was born, I am!" (Jn 8:58)

**Redeemer** - May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O LORD, my Rock and my Redeemer (Ps 19:14).

**Savior** - "The LORD lives! Praise be to my Rock! Exalted be God, the Rock, my Savior! (2 Sa 22:47); For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men. It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, while we wait for the blessed hope —the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ (Titus 2:11-13).

**Spirit** - Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters (Ge 1:2); "God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth" (Jn 4:24).

**Creator** - Remember your Creator in the days of your youth, before the days of trouble come and the years approach when you will say, 'I find no pleasure in them' " (Ecc 12:1).

**King** - Listen to my cry for help, my King and my God, for to you I pray (Ps 5:2).
